**3b. Some Suggested Action-Item Topics – things to watch and report about:**

- Muslim Brotherhood & Organization of Islamic Committee (OIC) wants to ban free speech in USA like Europe via UN. (In Europe, speaking truth about radical Islam, jihad, & sharia is illegal as defamation, bigotry, and Islamophobic.)

**Example:** Elisabeth Sabaditsch-Wolff, a free speech activist has been convicted in Austria with “denigration of religious beliefs of a legally recognized religion” for asserting that “Mohammed had a thing for little girls.” She has been fined up to €480. If she refuses to pay, she may spend a maximum of two months in jail.

- How to inform others about radical Islam, sharia law, Muslim Brotherhood, Halal foods, and their dangers to society.
- How to stop Islamic bias in our public schools; how to stop radical Islamic indoctrination in mosques and madrasses.
